2025 LEGISLATIVE NOTES By Kody Kyriss, SDATAT Lobbyist

The 100th legislative session is finally complete. As a whole, this was a busy legislative session for your Association with some highs and unfortunate lows towards the end of session.

Your Association leadership and I continued to follow some relevant bills as we went into the final week of session. **SB 169**, An Act to require that taxing districts hold a public hearing when increasing property tax revenues compared to the previous year, was hoghoused into an additional property tax bill, but then died on the House floor.

Additionally, **HB 1218**, An Act to prohibit certain political subdivisions from imposing firearm restrictions on the county, municipal, and township employees, officers, and volunteers was further amended and ultimately passed the legislative and awaits the Governor's signature.

Finally, your Association continued to monitor the property tax reform legislation that had been moving throughout the legislature. **SB 191** ultimately died on the House floor while **SB 216** was amended further, passed the legislative, and was signed by the Governor on March 13, 2025.

Your Association's bill, **SB 95**, additional funding for the Rural Access Infrastructure Fund, ultimately died on the House floor on March 10, 2025. Leading up to its being heard on the floor, your Association leadership and I diligently reached out to various members of the House to express the importance of additional RAIF funding. Unfortunately, the bill died on the House floor by a vote of 42-27 as it needed 2/3rds of the members to vote "yay" due to the bill appropriating general funds. While we will never know the reason for certainty, it is possible that your Association's efforts to kill HB 1261 resulted in the failure of SB 95 on the House floor. However, it is also important to remember that the budget for this year had always been an issue for any groups requesting money.

I again want to extend a huge thank you to you and your Association leadership for allowing me to lobby on your behalf for the 2025 legislative session. While we were not successful in receiving RAIF funds this year, your Association can always try again in future years where hopefully the budget will be friendlier. Regardless, your Association certainly made its presence known this session.

Please stay in touch with your local legislators and let them know how important township and rural infrastructure is to not only you but hunters, farmers, and the state as a whole.

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
